# VILLAGE OF CHAUVIN BYLAW #2019-03

# A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE COUNCIL TO AMEND BY-LAW # 2018-0-1 COUNCIL PROCEDURAL AND CODE OF CONDUCT

**WHEREAS** it is necessary to establish rules and provisions to regulate the conduct of business in Council meetings, to control and maintain order in Council for the enactment of municipal legislation and to provide for dealing with petitions, remonstrations and submissions to the Council.

## NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26.1 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAUVIN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT

#### DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this bylaw:

1. "Members" means an elected member of Council, including the Mayor and Deputy Mayor;

## **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

- 1. Members have a statutory duty to comply with the pecuniary interest provisions set out in Part 8, of Bylaw 2018-01 and a corresponding duty to act unless required or permitted to abstain under Bylaw 2018-01 or another enactment.
- 2. Members are to be free from undue influence and not act or appear to act in order to gain financial or other benefits for themselves, family, friends, or associates, business or otherwise.
- 3. Members shall approach decision-making with an open mind that is capable of persuasion.
- 4. It is the individual responsibility of each Member to seek independent legal advice, at the Member's sole expense, with respect to any situation that may result in a pecuniary or other conflict of interest.
